- CA when the bike becomes unsafe for training it is replaced
- IA Based on the availability of funds, a sponsor may apply for 50% replacement costs
- ID 5 year rotation
- IN replace up to 20 annually on an as needed basis
- KY As possible, rotate out older models.
- MD Our annual appropriation allows us to replace (3) bikes per year. There is an initiative process that must be completed for more.
- MO every 3-5 yrs
- NC 2 to 3 new loaners per site per year, allowing replacement of the entire fleet every 6 years
- ND Trade in motorcycles every 5 years.
- NV 10 year replacement
- OH We have budgeted for 100 motorcycles for each of the next two years.
- VT The program purchases 10 - 12 motorcycles each year. These motorcycle are used to open an additional site or replace aging motorcycles.

Describe it (q6735)

- CA The bike are check after every training session and repaired if necessary
- GA Annual maintenance and routine repair as reported.
- ID Owners manual
- IL Annual Inspection and replacement of any parts on the motorcycle. Repair or replace as needed.
- IN routine maintenance forms filled out by instructors/site coordinators before every course and

- retained in site records.
- KY Weekly visits. Repairs are made ASAP.
- MD Regular maintenance is done annually prior to the training season. Other items are maintained according to their useful life on a rotating basis.
- NC Lead instructor at each site performs annual and preventive maintenance. State office performs major repairs.
- ND Every spring and fall
- NM RiderCoaches identify mechanical/damage problems at end of each class; Site Coordinators perform maintenance before units are used for the next class.
- NY Inventory control records are kept that document maintenance activities. Individual training sites are responsible for routine maintenance during the training season. In the off-season, motorcycles are serviced according to a service plan at a central maintenance facility.
- OH We service all our program bikes annually during the winter. During the training season they are serviced and maintained by our sponsors.
- OR Quarterly service; annual detailed maintenance.
- PA a specific checklist listing all maintenance needs for each motorcycle
- WA Only on state owned but all motorcycles are required to be maintained in a manner to provide safe operation in a training environment
- WI Each site takes responsibility for maintenance. They either have a mechanic on staff or arrange with local dealers for maintenance.
