I'm working with our DOT on various things they can do to assist in bringing down motorcyclist fatalities. They have asked if any states use any motorcycle specific signage whether it's for awareness, work zones, sharp curves, etc. One that comes to mind is the flip up Texas sign that says Share the Road and something else on the back side.

Does your state use any motorcycle specific signage?

Does your state have any motorcycle specific messages they put on the DMS signs (over freeway signs)? We typically have done the "no lane splitting" and "helmets are required" but nothing that is impactful or creative. I'm looking for ideas.

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CT uses motorcycle signage on the roadway when there is uneven pavement or milled road during construction in work zones. Additionally when money is available we do a "share the road" billboard and radio campaign during peak riding months. We have been unable to use the VMS for motorcycle safety messaging because we have been told that FHWA will not support VMS being used in this manner.
