I pay \$23 per hour while working, and expenses to and from including lodging and meals based on per diem guidelines e.g. no mileage if within 50 miles of home. They don't get paid hourly wages for travel time. If it's a BRC evaluation they're expected to watch a minimum of 4 exercises and one full unit of classroom, with more time at their discretion but the report should explain why it was needed. They're expected to bill me for report writing or pre-visit prep if needed.
